

Campground General Policies

1. Purpose

These policies are established to ensure a safe, enjoyable, and respectful environment for all guests, staff, and visitors at the campground facility. All guests are responsible for understanding and complying with these policies during their stay.

2. Reservations and Check-In

- Guests must check in with the office upon arrival
 - Check-in time: 3:00PM Central Time
 - Check-out time: 11:00AM Central Time
 - Early arrivals or late departures require approval from the office. Just ask.
 - The registered guest is responsible for all members of their party and visitors.

3. Campsite Use

- Campers must occupy only their assigned site(s).
 - Campsites must be kept clean and orderly at all times.
 - If you reserve an RV site for longer than 3 days, we ask that you do not lay down large camper mats on the grass in order to avoid killing the grass. We will also need to mow.
 - Maximum vehicles per site: 2 vehicles. Additional parking area available, if needed.
 - Tents, RVs, and equipment must be placed within designated areas only.

4. Quiet Hours

- Quiet hours are enforced at 10PM Central Time daily.
 - During quiet hours, loud music, generators (unless medically required), and excessive noise are prohibited.
 - Guests must be respectful of neighboring campers at all times.

5. Visitors

- Visitors must comply with campground rules.
 - The registered camper assumes responsibility for visitors.

6. Fire Safety

- Fires are permitted only in designated fire rings or approved fire pits.
- Never leave fires unattended.
- Fires must be fully extinguished before leaving or sleeping.
- Fire bans issued by local authorities must be strictly followed. Ask the office if any existing bans are in order.
- Fireworks and explosive materials are strictly prohibited.

7. Wildlife and Environmental Protection

- Feeding wildlife is prohibited.
 - Food should be stored securely to prevent animal access.
 - Do not disturb plants, trees, or natural features.
 - Dispose of waste only in designated receptacles.

8. Pets

- Pets must be kept on a leash at all times.
 - Cabins are pet-friendly but will require an additional fee per pet.
 - Pets are NOT allowed in beds or on furniture.
 - If a pet is left alone inside a cabin, they must be in a kennel.
 - Guests must clean up all pet waste immediately and dispose of into trash
 - Excessive barking or aggressive behavior is not permitted.
 - The registered guest assumes responsibility for pet behavior and is expected to ensure the safety of all campers or visitors.

9. Vehicles and Parking

- Observe posted speed limits at all times (5–10 mph).

- Vehicles may be driven only on designated roads or where approved by management.
 - No vehicle washing or maintenance is allowed within campsites.
 - Parking is allowed only in designated areas.

10. Alcohol, Smoking, and Illegal Activities

- Alcohol consumption must comply with local laws.
 - No smoking allowed inside the cabins, bathhouse, cottage, or clubhouse.
 - Smoking is permitted outside only but guests must use the cigarette butt cans or firepits to dispose of all butts.
 - Illegal drugs, disorderly conduct, or disruptive behavior will result in removal from the campground.
 - We love our campground and put much effort into keeping it clean and well-maintained. Please help keep it looking great by doing your part to not toss cigarettes or trash outside of windows, in the gravel or grass areas.

11. Facilities and Amenities

- Restrooms, showers, and shared facilities must be kept clean.
 - Report maintenance issues to campground staff promptly.
 - Children under 10 must be supervised by an adult in all shared areas.

12. Safety and Emergencies

- First aid kits are located at: Office or Laundry Facility (at the bathhouse)
 - In case of emergency, call 911 and notify campground staff.
 - Guests must comply with instructions from staff during emergencies.
 - Storm shelter: In the event of a bad storm, guests may find shelter inside the clubhouse or bathhouse.

13. Waste Disposal

- Trash must be bagged and disposed of in designated dumpsters.
- Dumping of wastewater or hazardous materials is prohibited.

14. Liability

- Guests use campground facilities at their own risk.
 - The campground is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage to personal property.
 - Guests are responsible for damages caused by themselves, their children, pets, or visitors.

15. Enforcement

- Failure to comply with campground policies may result in warnings, fines, or removal without refund.
 - Management reserves the right to refuse service or terminate stays for safety or policy violations.

16. Policy Updates

Campground management reserves the right to modify these policies at any time to improve safety and operations.
